Dear Mr. Martin:

Saint Peregrine Chapel School's public water system has violated Ohio's safe drinking water laws. Specifically, Saint Peregrine Chapel School failed to conduct routine and repeat total coliform bacteria monitoring, failed to conduct initial lead and copper monitoring, and failed to issue public notices for many of these violations.

Owners or operators of public water systems that fail to comply with Ohio's safe drinking water laws and regulations are subject to civil penalties of up to \$25,000 per day per violation under Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 6109.33.

To resolve your drinking water violations and avoid possible legal action and civil penalties:

- 1) Monitor for total coliform bacteria with a minimum of one routine sample per calendar quarter from the distribution system and perform any required repeat monitoring, in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-81-21.
- 2) Immediately comply with the maximum contaminant level requirements for total coliform bacteria, in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-81-14.
- 3) Between January 1 and June 30, 2004, conduct initial lead and copper monitoring. By not later than July 10, 2003 submit the monitoring results and the ninetieth percentile lead and copper concentrations to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Northeast District Office (NEDO), Division of Drinking and Ground Waters (DDAGW), Attn: Ursula Musselman, 2110 E. Aurora Road, Twinsburg, Ohio, 44087-1969, in accordance with OAC Rules 3745-81-86 and 3745-81-89.


- 5) By April 15, 2004, post public notices for past total coliform, and lead and copper monitoring violations for at least fourteen (14) days and submit copies of the public notices and verification forms to Ohio EPA, NEDO, DDAGW, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-81-32.
- 6) Comply with the monitoring and reporting requirements in accordance with the 2004 chemical monitoring schedule.
