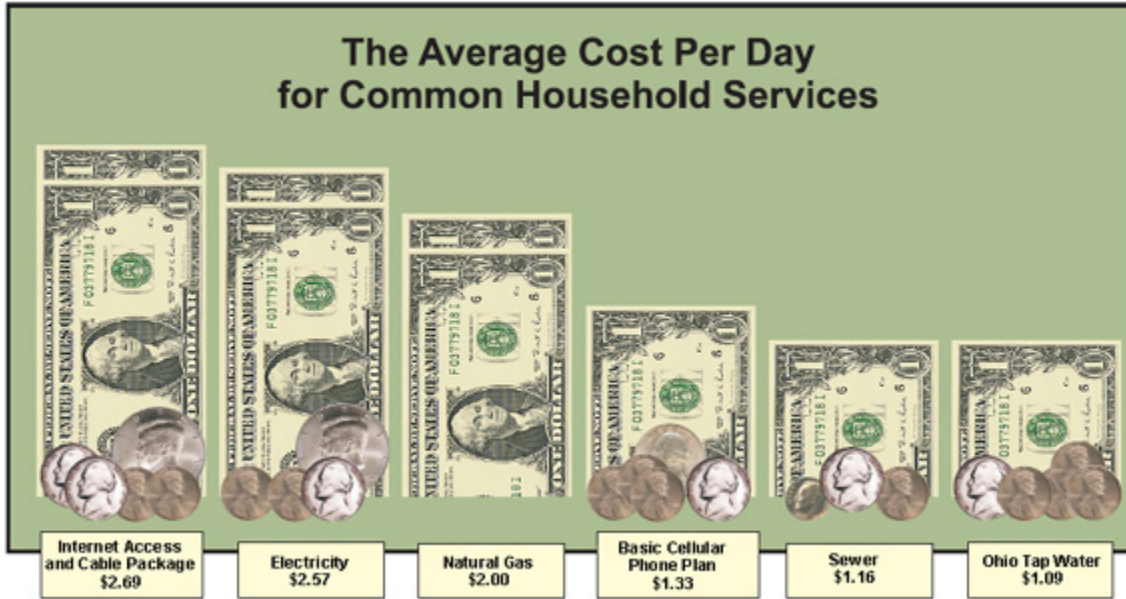


**Ohio Tap Water -
Clean, Convenient, Safe and Affordable**

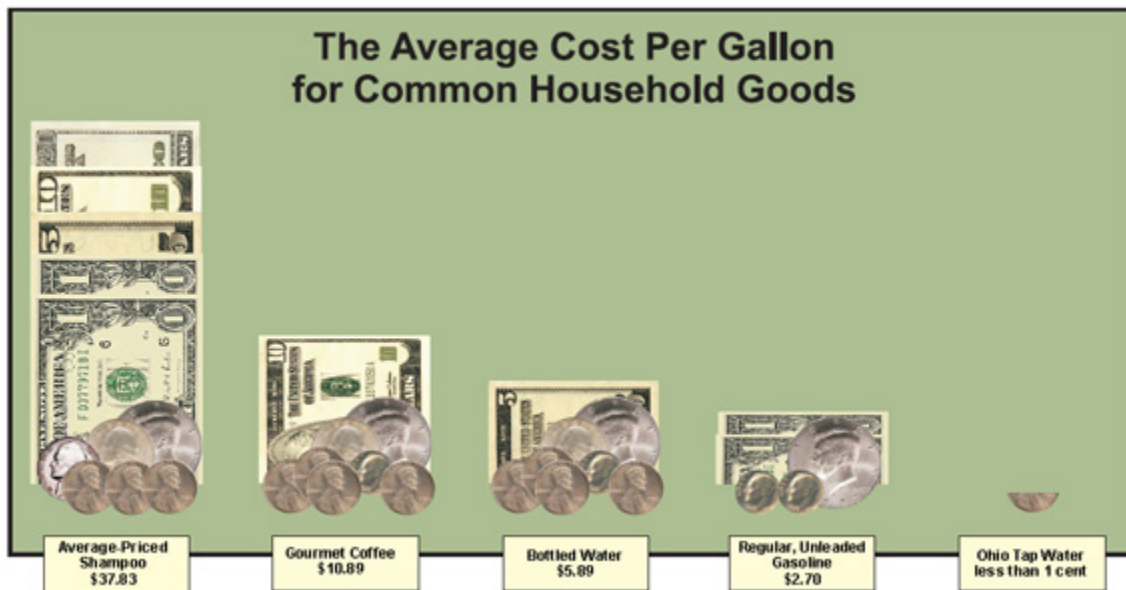
Do you know the value of your tap water?

Think about how you spend money on a daily basis. Did you drive your car to work, grab a cup of coffee at the shop near you, use electricity to dry your hair, or call a friend on your cellular phone? You probably think of these things as relatively low-cost conveniences that improve the quality of your life.

Consider for a moment how convenient it is to have [clean, safe water](#) delivered to the faucets in your home, especially compared to the costs of other services as shown in the chart below.



As you can see on the chart below, tap water delivered to homes in Ohio costs a mere penny per gallon on average, but did you know that there is a complex process involved in producing and delivering safe, clean tap water to your faucets?



Everyday behind the scenes, an extensive network of professionals, resources and infrastructure works to ensure that you have a reliable source of clean, safe water. Engineers design the water treatment and distribution plants; certified plant operators oversee the treatment and distribution of tap water; mechanics maintain the pipelines that distribute the water; chemists test the water for unwanted contaminants; and the water provider, Ohio EPA and U.S. EPA assure that the entire production is within the scientific regulations that protect public health.
