Ohio EPA, Carey Company Resolve Violations

Bosserman Aviation Equipment, Inc., of Carey, will pay a \$20,000 civil penalty to Ohio EPA for hazardous waste management violations at the 2327 State Route 568 business. The violations have been corrected.

During multiple inspections at the facility since 2006, Ohio EPA cited several violations. These included:

- failing to evaluate wastes generated to determine if they are hazardous;
- illegally storing hazardous wastes for more than 180 days without a permit;
- failing to keep containers in waste generation areas closed and failing to label them with the words "hazardous waste";
- failing to properly label containers and include the date that accumulation began;
- failing to conduct and record inspections of the emergency equipment and of the container storage area; and
- transporting hazardous waste to an unpermitted facility.

The company operates an aircraft re-fueling building, servicing and refurbishing facility. It is considered a small quantity generator of hazardous waste. Wastes include waste paint, solvents and distillation bottoms, used oil, rags and scrap metal. No releases of hazardous wastes occurred.

The penalty will be paid to Ohio EPA's hazardous waste cleanup fund in 12 installments every 90 days for three years. A copy of the settlement is available online at <http://www.epa.ohio.gov/dhwm/2009aco.aspx>.
