The Ohio EPA TRI program would like to remind you that the deadline to submit TRI forms for reporting year 2020 is midnight on July 1, 2021.

Ohio EPA participates in the TRI State Data Exchange (CDX) System through which U.S. EPA automatically forwards your TRI-ME web submission directly to our Ohio database. Once you certify your electronic TRI submission to U.S. EPA, your facility has successfully satisfied your reporting obligation to both U.S. EPA and Ohio EPA.

OHIO TRI FILING FEES HAVE BEEN ELIMINATED: NO FEES ARE DUE FOR REPORTING YEAR 2020

As part of the 2018-2019 biennium budget, the TRI fees were eliminated in Ohio. Ohio EPA's Division of Air Pollution Control will continue to administer the TRI Program and provide assistance to the regulated community and the public. U.S. EPA continues to administer the national reporting program, by providing web-based reporting, web-based training, and user-friendly web-based access to the TRI data.
